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
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Educational Philosophy

CCC, a ministry partner of Faith Lutheran Church, is a Christian-based educational organization that provides quality care for children ages six weeks through 14 years.



The Center provides supervision, activities and programs for the spiritual, social/emotional, cognitive and physical development of children. We are proud to present a safe, loving, nurturing environment and age-appropriate classrooms for learning and growth during the most important developmental period in a child's life.

CCC offers an infant/toddler program for six weeks to two years, a three year-old program, and a pre-kindergarten program for four to five year-olds. CCC is licensed by the State of Wisconsin, follows "The Creative Curriculum[®]" comprehensive learning approach, and incorporates Christian teachings into daily activities.

CCC's values support the development of children and the role of the single parent and working families. Both teachers and support staff work in partnership with the parents and provides the peace of mind that their children are in a loving, safe and enjoyable environment while parents are at work.

Celebration Children's Center welcomes and encourages volunteerism. It does not discriminate based on a child's ability or disability.

Christian Environment

CCC offers quality child care in an enriching Christian environment. Staff model Christian values and thoughtfully weave religious concepts into the daily curriculum and learning activities. All children are exposed to songs and music, as well as stories and prayer that stimulate spiritual growth.

In CCC's toddler through Pre-K rooms, teachers share various Christian-based activities during Jesus Time. Bible stories, flannel boards, songs, and projects emphasize God's words in fun, interactive and creative ways.

The children in our three/four year-old rooms participate in Jesus Time more frequently and also take part in a weekly chapel time.

Children in CCC's Pre-K room receive a unique opportunity to experience God's teachings as they interact with students from Celebration Lutheran School. Once each week the children participate in an activity presented by the 8th graders. This is a wonderful way to teach our young children about leadership in a Christian environment.

Caring Environment

God's Little Angels and Noah's Ark Infant and Toddler Rooms

- Daily routines are created around meeting each child's basic needs.
- Individual plans are developed for each child's skill level to encourage successful development.
- Families are involved in all aspects of their child's care.

Jonah's Whales and Lions Den Two and Three year-old Rooms

- Independence, self-help skill building and problem-solving are the main areas of focus for these rooms.
- Environment, materials and weekly lesson plans focus on developmentally appropriate skills and activities for each age group.
- Potty training is encouraged and practiced in these two rooms.
- Language development, basic math skills, and science concepts are incorporated into these classroom environments.

Promised Land Preschool Classroom

- Teachers use instructional methods and guidance to encourage children to develop the social and emotional skills they'll need to succeed in school.
- Instructional approach includes both teacher-directed and child-initiated learning.
- Environment, materials and weekly lesson plans focus on developmentally appropriate skills and activities for this age group.
- Literacy, mathematics, science, social studies, and Christian ethics are incorporated into this curriculum.
